ITA BUTTROSE AO, OBE NATIONAL PRESIDENT, ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA I'M REALLY PLEASED TO BE HERE AND TO WELCOME YOU ALL TO ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA'S 15<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL CONFERENCE, IN THIS DELIGHTFUL CITY OF HOBART.

I WANT TO THANK EVERYONE WHO HAS WORKED HARD OVER THE PAST
TWO YEARS TO MAKE THIS CONFERENCE HAPPEN, PARTICULARLY
ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA TASMANIA AND THEIR CEO DEBBIE SLATER AND
ALSO OUR CONFERENCE MANAGERS AT LEISHMAN ASSOCIATES.

AND MY THANKS TO ALL OF YOU TOO FOR MAKING THE COMMITMENT TO BE HERE. SOME OF YOU HAVE TRAVELLED LONG DISTANCES, BUT I AM CERTAIN IT WILL BE WORTH YOUR WHILE.

I HOPE THAT THE NEXT THREE DAYS WILL CHALLENGE YOU TO REFLECT
ON YOUR EXPERIENCES OF LIVING WITH DEMENTIA, STRETCH YOUR
THINKING ABOUT THE DISEASE AND GENERATE IDEAS AND SUGGESTIONS
ON HOW WE CAN BEST CARE FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA NOW
WHILE BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE.

I CAN'T BELIEVE IT'S ONLY TWO YEARS SINCE I ADDRESSED MY FIRST
NATIONAL CONFERENCE IN BRISBANE, JUST A COUPLE OF MONTHS
AFTER BECOMING NATIONAL PRESIDENT.

IT SEEMS LIKE A LIFETIME AGO. WHAT A WHIRLWIND COUPLE OF YEARS IT HAS BEEN.

I KNEW A FAIR BIT ABOUT THE DEMENTIA JOURNEY HAVING BEEN MY
FATHER'S PRINCIPAL CARER WHEN HE BATTLED VASCULAR DEMENTIA
BUT THE JOURNEY I'VE BEEN ON SINCE BECOMING PRESIDENT HAS BEEN
EXTRAORDINARY.

I'VE MET PEOPLE FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE FROM ALL PARTS OF
AUSTRALIA. I'VE MET UNFORGETTABLE PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA AND
BEEN TOUCHED TO THE HEART BY THEIR BRAVERY AND THE STORIES
THEY HAVE SHARED WITH US.

AND I'VE MET CARERS FOR WHOM MY ADMIRATION KNOWS NO
BOUNDS...WHAT INCREDIBLE MEN AND WOMEN THEY ARE...AND HOW
WELL I REMEMBER THE CARER IN SYDNEY WHO SPOKE ABOUT THE UPS
AND DOWNS OF CARING FOR HIS WIFE WHO HAS ALZHEIMER'S
DISEASE...AS HE FINISHED HIS STORY, HE LOOKED AT US AND SAID:
"IT'S A PRIVILEGE TO HELP A PERSON LIVE THEIR LIFE."

I'M SURE HE SPOKE FOR ALL CARERS OF PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA THAT DAY.

IT WAS AT THE BRISBANE NATIONAL CONFERENCE THAT THE MINISTER
FOR MENTAL HEALTH AND AGEING, MARK BUTLER, ENCOURAGED US TO
TELL OUR PERSONAL STORIES. HE TOLD US THAT THE STORIES OF
PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA WERE NOT HEARD OFTEN ENOUGH. I
THINK WE CAN CONFIDENTLY SAY THAT THIS IS NO LONGER THE CASE.

THE FIGHT DEMENTIA CAMPAIGN WAS LAUNCHED IN OCTOBER 2011 WITH A MARCH OF 500 PEOPLE – PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA, CARERS AND HEALTH PROFESSIONALS – ON THE LAWNS OF PARLIAMENT HOUSE, CANBERRA. IT WAS INSPIRATIONAL. SO MANY OF THOSE MARCHING SAID, "IT IS JUST SO WONDERFUL THAT WE ARE DOING SOMETHING."

NOT LONG AFTER, WE UNDERTOOK NATIONWIDE CONSULTATIONS ON THE AGED CARE REFORMS AND HEARD THE STORIES OF THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA AND THEIR FAMILIES. WE WERE PLEASED TO REPORT THESE BACK TO GOVERNMENT WHERE THEY DID RESONATE.

MINISTER BUTLER TOLD ME A COUPLE OF WEEKS AGO THAT HE BELIEVED EVERY POLITICIAN IN THE FEDERAL PARLIAMENT WAS NOW AWARE OF DEMENTIA AND THE PUBLIC HEALTH CHALLENGE THAT IT REPRESENTS.

OF COURSE THERE WERE SOME WONDERFUL STORIES OF GOOD CARE.

BUT THE OVERWHELMING MESSAGE WAS THAT THE AGED CARE SYSTEM

WAS BADLY FAILING PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA.

MOST RECENTLY, PEOPLE UNDER 65, LIVING WITH DEMENTIA HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCES AT OUR YOUNGER ONSET DEMENTIA SUMMIT IN MELBOURNE.

ONCE AGAIN, MOVING STORIES WERE SHARED ABOUT WHAT IT MEANS TO LIVE WITH DEMENTIA AND THE SPECIAL ISSUES THAT YOUNGER PEOPLE FACE, INCLUDING THE IMPACT A DIAGNOSIS HAS ON CHILDREN AND THE FINANCIAL BURDEN CAUSED BY LOSS OF EMPLOYMENT.

WE HAVE DOCUMENTED THE HOPES AND PRIORITIES OF THE

PARTICIPANTS IN A REPORT: "YOUNGER ONSET DEMENTIA: A NEW

HORIZON?"

PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA ARE THE BACKBONE OF OUR FIGHT
DEMENTIA CAMPAIGN AND THE REASON WHY IT HAS BEEN SO
SUCCESSFUL IN COMMUNICATING THE IMPACT DEMENTIA IS HAVING ON
SO MANY AUSTRALIAN FAMILIES.

AND I AM PROUD TO SAY THAT OUR ACHIEVEMENTS HAVE GIVEN NEW MEANING TO THE WORD "FIGHT".

THE STORIES FROM THE YOUNGER ONSET DEMENTIA SUMMIT REACHED
AN AUDIENCE OF MORE THAN 3.7 MILLION PEOPLE.

OUR MARCH ON PARLIAMENT HOUSE REACHED AN AUDIENCE OF 7.6

MILLION...MY FIRST EVER PROTEST MARCH. I ENJOYED IT IMMENSELY.

THE RELEASE OF OUR AGED CARE CONSULTATION REPORT BROKE ALL OUR MEDIA RECORDS REACHING AN AUDIENCE OF 16 MILLION.

AND IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS CHANNEL 9, CHANNEL 10 AND THE ABC HAVE RUN FEATURE STORIES ON THE LIVES OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA AND THE MAJOR TABLOIDS AND RADIO STATIONS ARE ALSO REPORTING AND RUNNING STORIES ON DEMENTIA.

AND THAT'S JUST TRADITIONAL MEDIA. SOCIAL MEDIA HAS ENABLED PEOPLE TO COMMUNICATE THEIR STORIES IN A WAY THAT WE HAVE NEVER DONE BEFORE.

IN THE LEAD UP TO VALENTINE'S DAY LAST YEAR, PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA AND THEIR CARERS BOMBARDED OUR POLITICAL LEADERS WITH CARDS ASKING: 'WHAT WOULD YOU DO IF YOUR LOVED ONE COULDN'T REMEMBER YOU?' WE REACHED ALMOST 90,000 PEOPLE ON TWITTER AND 300,000 ON FACEBOOK.

THE LEADER OF THE FEDERAL OPPOSITION, TONY ABBOTT, WHEN HE TWEETED HIS THANKS.

WHEN I CARED FOR MY FATHER, WE DIDN'T HAVE THE LUXURY OF INSTANTLY SHARING OUR THOUGHTS AND EXPERIENCES WITH THE REST OF THE WORLD THROUGH THE CLICK OF A BUTTON.

NOW THAT WE DO, I AM CERTAINLY MAKING THE MOST OF IT. I HAVE A
TWITTER ACCOUNT AND HOPE THAT ALL THE TWEETERS IN THE
AUDIENCE WILL JOIN ME TO CREATE AN ONLINE CONVERSATION ABOUT
OUR NATIONAL CONFERENCE BY USING THE HASHTAG #ALZAUS2013.

OUR FIGHT DEMENTIA CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN IN THE MEDIA SPOT LIGHT FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS AND WE NOW HAVE 48 FEDERAL POLITICIANS WHO HAVE PLEDGED THEIR SUPPORT AS DEMENTIA CHAMPIONS. WE ALSO HAVE THOUSANDS OF COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS AND A SOCIAL NETWORK OF MORE THAN 20,000 SUPPORTERS.

I THINK OUR SUCCESS HAS BEEN HELPED BY OUR ABILITY TO RESPOND
TO THE QUESTION POLITICIANS OFTEN ASK WHEN THEY START TO
BECOME INTERESTED IN AN ISSUE: WHAT DO YOU WANT?

IN PHASE ONE OF THE CAMPAIGN WE ASKED FOR A \$500 MILLION OVER FIVE YEARS TO IMPROVE DEMENTIA AWARENESS, EARLY DIAGNOSIS, CARE AND SUPPORT, RISK REDUCTION AND FOR INVESTMENT IN RESEARCH.

WE DID HAVE CONSIDERABLE SUCCESS.

LAST YEAR, PRIME MINISTER GILLARD, AND MINISTER BUTLER

COMMITTED TO TACKLING DEMENTIA WITH A \$270 MILLION OVER FIVE

YEARS PACKAGE THROUGH THE *LIVING LONGER. LIVING BETTER.* AGED

CARE REFORMS. THIS COMMITMENT REFLECTS A NEW DETERMINATION TO

TACKLE DEMENTIA, BOTH AS A HEALTH AND AGED CARE ISSUE.

IT INCLUDES ACTION ON TIMELY DIAGNOSIS, MAKING HOSPITALS SAFER,
DEMENTIA RISK REDUCTION, ADDITIONAL RESOURCES TO PROVIDE
QUALITY DEMENTIA CARE AND, FOR THE FIRST TIME, SUPPORT FOR
YOUNGER PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA.

HOWEVER WE DID NOT SECURE THE \$200 MILLION OVER FIVE YEARS WE BELIEVE IS ESSENTIAL FOR DEMENTIA RESEARCH AND ANXIOUSLY AWAIT NEWS OF THIS EVENING'S BUDGET.

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF *LIVING LONGER. LIVING BETTER.* WILL GET US
TO FIRST BASE IN AGED CARE REFORM AND TACKLING DEMENTIA.

THE IMPERATIVE IS TO BUILD ON THAT PLATFORM. OUR FIGHT DEMENTIA

CAMPAIGN – ELECTION 2013 SETS OUT HOW THAT CAN BE ACHIEVED IN

THE NEXT THREE YEARS. THE PRIORITIES ARE TO:

- INCREASE THE GROWTH OF COMMUNITY CARE HIGH CARE
   PACKAGES FOR PEOPLE WHO OTHERWISE WOULD BE
   FORCED INTO RESIDENTIAL CARE
- EXPAND ACCESS TO FLEXIBLE DEMENTIA-FRIENDLY RESPITE

  CARE
- IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF RESIDENTIAL DEMENTIA CARE
- SECURE THE AGREEMENT OF HEALTH MINISTERS TO A NEW
   NATIONAL ACTION FRAMEWORK ON DEMENTIA
- AND TO INVEST \$200 MILLION OVER FIVE YEARS IN DEMENTIA RESEARCH...BUT OF COURSE, THAT WILL DEPEND ON THIS EVENING'S BUDGET.

I SAID AT THE OUTSET OF THE FIGHT DEMENTIA CAMPAIGN THAT I HAVE
TAKEN OFF THE VELVET GLOVE AND PUT ON THE IRON FIST...IT IS STILL
THERE BECAUSE THERE IS NO REASON TO RELAX.

TONIGHT I WANTED TO TELL YOU ABOUT, WHAT I THINK HAS BEEN A
TREMENDOUS EFFORT, ON THE PART OF ALL OF US OVER THE PAST TWO
YEARS, TO GET DEMENTIA ON THE NATIONAL AGENDA.

WE HAVE DONE IT TOGETHER AND WE MUST REMAIN UNITED AND POSITIVE.

WE HAVE BEEN HELPED BY BIPARTISAN SUPPORT FROM BOTH SIDES OF POLITICS FOR ACTION ON DEMENTIA AND I AM GREATLY ENCOURAGED BY THIS SUPPORT.

TOMORROW MORNING I WILL HAVE MORE TO SAY ABOUT THE FUTURE

AND THE STRATEGIES WHICH I THINK WILL BE CRUCIAL IN REDUCING THE

STIGMA AND SOCIAL ISOLATION THAT RESULTS FROM A DIAGNOSIS OF

DEMENTIA.

THEY ARE BOTH SIGNIFICANT GOALS THAT ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA IS DETERMINED TO ACHIEVE.

THANK YOU.

NOW I WANT TO WELCOME PROFESSOR HENRY BRODATY – WHO I'M SURE IS WELL KNOWN TO YOU ALL.

HENRY IS SCIENTIA PROFESSOR OF AGEING AND MENTAL HEALTH,
MONTEFIORE CHAIR OF HEALTHY BRAIN AGEING, DIRECTOR OF THE
DEMENTIA COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH CENTRE AND CO-DIRECTOR OF
THE CENTRE FOR HEALTH BRAIN AGEING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW
SOUTH WALES.

HE IS HEAD OF THE MEMORY DISORDERS CLINIC AT PRINCE OF WALES
HOSPITAL IN SYDNEY AND PRESIDENT-ELECT OF THE INTERNATIONAL
PSYCHOGERIATRIC ASSOCIATION

HENRY IS ALSO PAST PRESIDENT OF ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA AND OF ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA NSW.

TO GIVE THIS EVENING'S KEYNOTE ADDRESS ON THE PHYSICAL COMORBIDITIES IN PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA. PLEASE WELCOME PROFESSOR HENRY BRODATY.

AND NOW FOR A SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT – ONE THAT I HAVE BEEN LOOKING FORWARD TO MAKING.

TONIGHT IT IS MY GREAT PLEASURE TO PRESENT PROFESSOR HENRY BRODATY WITH THE LIFETIME ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA AWARD.

HENRY HAS DEDICATED A LIFETIME OF LEADERSHIP, CLINICAL EXCELLENCE AND RESEARCH TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH DEMENTIA.

HE HAS ACHIEVED MANY KEY LANDMARKS IN HIS CAREER AT THE
INTERNATIONAL LEVEL. IN 1984 HENRY JOINED THE SCIENTIFIC AND
RESEARCH COMMITTEE OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE INTERNATIONAL (ADI).
HE HAS SINCE CONTINUED TO REPRESENT AUSTRALIA AT THE
INTERNATIONAL LEVEL AS CHAIRMAN AND HONORARY LIFETIME VICE
PRESIDENT OF ADI.

IN 1993 HE JOINED THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND THEN FROM 2011-2013
WENT ON TO BE PRESIDENT-ELECT OF THE INTERNATIONAL
PSYCHOGERIATRIC ASSOCIATION. HENRY WAS ALSO A FOUNDING
COUNCIL MEMBER IN 2001 AND EXECUTIVE MEMBER IN 2009 OF THE
INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE OF GERIATRIC PSYCHONEUROPHARMACOLOGY.

IN AUSTRALIA, HENRY WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE ROYAL AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND COLLEGE OF PSYCHIATRY NSW BRANCH FROM 1982-1984; DURING THIS TIME HE WAS ALSO THE FOUNDING MEMBER AND INAUGURAL PRESIDENT OF ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA NSW AND FROM 1988-1991 HE BECAME NATIONAL PRESIDENT OF ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA; HENRY IS NOW THE CHAIR OF THE ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA DEMENTIA RESEARCH FOUNDATION.

HE HAS ALSO WON A MULTITUDE OF AWARDS, THE MOST RECENT BEING
THE UNIVERSITY OF NSW DEAN OF MEDICINE'S AWARD FOR COMMUNITY
ENGAGEMENT, WHICH IS THE HIGHEST AWARD MADE BY THE FACULTY OF
MEDICINE IN RECOGNITION OF SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE AREAS
OF EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITY.

THESE ARE JUST A FEW OF THE MANY ACHIEVEMENTS HENRY HAS

ACCOMPLISHED IN HIS CARE... I'D ALSO LIKE TO ACKNOWLEDGE HENRY

ON A PERSONAL LEVEL – HE IS A VERY SPECIAL HUMAN BEING AND I FEEL

SO HONOURED TO KNOW HIM. HE HAS AN UNWAVERING WILL TO

CONTINUALLY HELP AND PUT OTHER PEOPLE FIRST.

HENRY'S PASSION, HARD WORK AND GENEROSITY HAS BEEN AND REMAINS AN IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTOR TO THE STRONG ORGANISATION THAT ALZHEIMER'S AUSTRALIA HAS BECOME TODAY – ONE WHICH HAS CREDIBILITY WITHIN AUSTRALIA AND INTERNATIONALLY.
