All Dementia Australia members are bound by our Constitution. As a company limited by guarantee, Dementia Australia members provide a guarantee under our Constitution in the event of a winding up. This guarantee is limited to \$10. Dementia Australia membership and its rights are personal to the member and are not transferable.

Membership fees

Membership is subject to our receipt of your completed Membership Application Form and, for Premium Membership, payment of the membership fee.

Premium Membership fees are payable in advance annually and we generally send a reminder approximately one to two months before the renewal date. Regular membership will be automatically renewed unless you cancel it.

Cancellation of membership

You may cancel your membership at any time by providing us with either verbal or written notification.

Refund policy

Dementia Australia reserves the right to provide any refunds at our discretion. Pro-rata refunds for membership are not available.

Lapsing of membership

If your fee is overdue for more than one (1) month you will cease to be a member of the Dementia Australia and will not be entitled to access any benefits and entitlements of membership.
