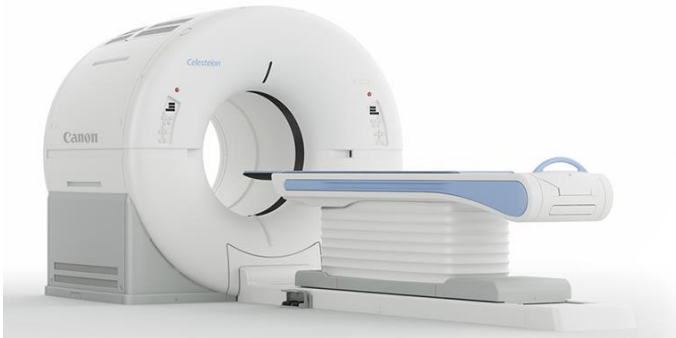

A Clinical Research Study Examining Eye and Brain Health

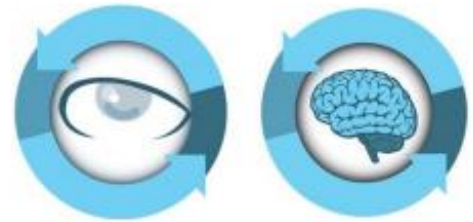

Participants wanted

This project seeks to identify whether the eye and brain tests can serve as early diagnostic markers for Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia.

Participants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. 50+ years of age**
- 2. No significant history of eye/vision disorders**



By participating in this study, you will undergo a comprehensive ophthalmic examination, neuropsychological tests and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI). We will also collect a small sample of blood to be analysed in the lab.

Any abnormalities found from the ophthalmic and cognitive examinations will be referred for follow up by the study investigators.

The study takes a maximum of **3 hrs**, including pupil dilation with an additional 30-45 min allocated for an MRI organised separately.

Participants will be reimbursed \$40 voucher for their time.
