Who

Researchers from the University of Sydney are seeking participants who are:

≥ 18 years old

- Vision impairment *OR*
- Acquired brain injury ≥ 6 months post-injury

≥ 65 years old

- With mild memory or thinking problems *OR*
- Healthy control

Why

The study is to test a custom-made, fully immersive VR shopping program to enhance supermarket shopping skills. It may help improve your confidence and ability to take part in everyday activities.



What & Where

- Two 30-minute sessions each week for four weeks.
- 45-minute assessments of physical function, perceived performance, confidence and quality of life will be conducted before program begins and after it ends.
- 15-minute questionnaire and 30-minute interview.
